

1. Topic: Different types of soil found in Gujarat and Chhattisgarh (Research Based)



3. Topic: Formation of Shadow (Experiment Based)

Learning Objectives: Students will be able to understand the position of shadow at different times.

Materials Required: Chart paper, pencil, clay, other stationery items.

Procedure:

- 1. Use the clay to position the pencil upright in the center of the poster board.
- 2. Place the poster board outside in a sunny, flat area away from trees and other tall objects. Put a rock on each corner of the poster board.

- 3. Measure the length of the pencil's shadow. Mark the end of the shadow. Record the time of day and your measurement on the poster board.
- 4. Observe the position of the sun and the direction of the shadow in relation to the sun. Record your observations in the table below, along with your measurements of the shadow.

Sr. No	Time	Length of the shadow

Caution: Do not look directly at the sun.

5 Repeat steps 3 and 4 each hour throughout the day.

Questions:

- 1. Will the shadow form at 12 noon? Justify your answer.
- 2. Which factors are responsible for the position of shadow?
- 3. What are the necessary conditions required for the formation of shadow?

Learning Outcomes: Students will be able to demonstrate the formation of shadow.



Learning Objective - Students will demonstrate their understanding of numbers.


Paste your photograph in a chart paper and write five things about yourself. In the sentences/terms you can use any mathematical operation.
