Pictures of garments of Kosa silk and Patola silk fabrics, File, Papers to write report

Procedure:

Research the textiles of Gujarat and Chhattisgarh on the following points:

- Types of fabrics produced in both the states.
 (Main fabric production of chhattisgarh Main fabric production of Gujrat)
- Main source of Kosa silk Fibres and its Characteristics
- Manufacturing of Kosa Silk fabric of Chhattisgarh and Patola Silk fabric of Gujarat
- Techniques used to manufacture Kosa Silk and Patola Silk
- Difference in the dying process of both fabrics
- Best methods of washing both the fabrics
- Contribution of textile industries in the economy of the state.

II. Topic: Experimental Based Summer Assignment

Aim: To prepare Black Grape Indicator

Learning Objectives:

- To enable students to differentiate various acids and bases
- To enable students to explain the information about the PH range of the acidic and basic solutions
- To enable students to explain the 'Science in Kitchen'.

Material Required:

Black grapes, six test tubes (or paper cups), Cork, Dropper, Milk, Water, Baking soda, Toothpaste, Lemon juice, Vinegar, Washing Powder.

Procedure:

First, extract the juice of black grapes, and take some test tubes/ paper cups. Then, take specific amount of the following items in each paper cup:

Milk, Water, Baking Soda, Soda Drink, Lemon Juice, Vinegar

After that, pour the black grape juice in each cup until the colour of the liquid/powder [baking soda] changes. Note down your observations regarding the nature of acid and base in each item as indicated by the black grapes.

Observations: (Students should write their own observations accordingly)

Based on above observation answer the following questions:

Q1. Is grape juice acidic or basic?

Q2. Which color is indicated by grape juice in acidic solution?

Q3. Which color is indicated by grape juice in the basic/alkaline solution?





PROJECT FILE- "REDUCING TISSUE PAPER USAGE: A SUSTAINABLE INITIATIVE"

Background: Tissue paper is a ubiquitous product that is widely used for personal hygiene, cleaning, and wiping it impacts Pollution & Deforestation.



Project Objective:

As we all know, tissue paper usage has become an integral part of our daily lives. From using it in washrooms to cleaning spills and wiping hands, it is hard to imagine life without tissue paper. However, the excessive usage of tissue paper has a severe impact on the environment. The manufacturing and disposal of tissue paper contribute to deforestation, water pollution etc. Hence your task to come up with innovative ideas to reduce tissue paper usage and promote sustainable alternatives. Your ideas should be

- 3. An estimate of the costs involved and potential savings.
- 4. An analysis of the potential impact of your solutions on the environment and society.

Make a visual representation of your project. This can be in project file with info graphics. The presentation of your project to your classmates and teacher should be no longer than 10 minutes and should include a summary of your solution, visual aids, and a Q&A session.

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
7. SUMMER ASSIGNMENT – MATHEMATICS

- · All parts can be used upside down if needed.






Learning Outcome- Students will able to create pictures using different geometrical shapes and identify them.


