

On the first day teachers involved themselves in team building activities with a special emphasis on inculcating the feeling of a community. Principal Mr. Pankaj Joshi took an influential session on the impact and implications of the POCSO act. Later during the day, participants spent their time visualizing what in their opinion could be an ideal image of AWS. This was displayed through charts exhibited in the school.

## Experiential Learning -Teaching through Effective Engagement

Yet another day with learned minds to understand that Knowledge is experience, everything else is just information.

The Resource Person - Prof. B L Handoo and Dr. Avatar Singh through easy story telling method with relevant examples began the session with discussion of changing the paradigm from Traditional Teaching to Experiential Learning Methodology. Prof. Handoo explained how reconstruction and reorganisation of experience is education.

The session envisaged the teachers to give tangible experiences with hands - on learning activities . learning must display a change in overt behaviour. The Five-Cycle Process of Experiential Learning i.e. Experience,

Share, Process, Generalise and Apply, the learnings of the students were explained to the teachers to ignite and integrate the cognition, perception, behaviour, experience, and reflection of their learners in a Holistic Learning Process. The teachers learnt about The Learning Pyramid, Kohler and Koffka experiment, the Theory of Experiential Learning and The Nine Keys to Experiential Learning.

An interactive session was conducted after the training where Prof. Handoo cleared the queries of the teachers. The session concluded with a Dazzling Dance Fusion of Odissi, Kathak and Ravindra Sangeet performance by the dance teachers. Prof. Handoo also gave an overview on how the dance forms can be integrated for learning of different subjects.
